How To's:

Entering the classroom: Quietly listen, be seated and ready to learn with all materials. Begin correcting your homework and follow the agenda. If you are tardy, come in quickly and join the current class activity.

Assignments: Write the assignments listed on the board in your calendar. Homework is due at the beginning of class in your notebook. Be sure that your work is neat and easily read so it can be easily corrected. Always show your own work. Try to do as much math mentally without your calculator. If you don't have your homework, get a "missing work" slip to have signed by your parent and returned the next day. Late work will be accepted up to 2 days after it was due with two points off, or it will given a zero.

Absence: Be responsible to get class notes from another student and complete missed work within two days.

During class: Use your time wisely. When your classwork is done please begin your homework. You can approach me with whatever question/need you have. Feel free to move around the classroom for things like trash or tissue, as long as it isn't a distraction to others. During lecture/discussion you should be in your seat listening and taking notes. Please raise your hand and wait for me to acknowledge you during a lecture. Ask for permission to leave the class and return quickly with minimum distraction. I will dismiss you at the end of class.

Borrowing things: Ask a classmate to borrow something that you do not have. If they don't have it, you may borrow it from me. Return the items before you leave the classroom.

Substitute teachers: Your behavior should be as good as or better than if I were there. Conduct normal class routines and work the entire period.
